This program will start on time, to insure that everyone will get home before it starts to get dark. The program is essentially a repeat of last year's December program. The first part of the program is a collection of 20 crazy TV commercials from the 1950's and 1960's, and a film short entitled "Famous Jews Who Changed Their Names". Then we will see a one hour program " My Yiddishe Chanukah", featuring members of the Folksbiene Yiddish Theater. The songs are in a variety of languages: mostly Yiddish, but also includes songs in Hebrew, English and Ladino. The songs are a mix of old and new Chanukah songs plus a few classic Yiddish theater songs, and a few others.

This Program will be at 1:00 PM on Sunday, December 17 (the third Sunday in December) at Temple Emanuel, Franklin Lakes. Please note the earlier starting time, so people could return home before it starts to get dark

The program is open to the public with no admission or refreshment charge, but people will have the opportunity to make SMALL voluntary donations to support these synagogue programs.
